WHEREAS, to identify and preserve important archaeological and historic resources within the County is a goal set by the County General Plan (Goal 9-31); and WHEREAS, the County Historical Landmarks Advisory Committee (HLAC) was established to select eligible sites and places in the County to be designated as points of historical interest; and WHEREAS, on September 10, 2008 an application by the Knightsen Town Advisory Council nominating the original Knightsen Townsite and the Nail Ranch properties in Knightsen as historical resources was presented to the HLAC; and WHEREAS, the HLAC having reviewed the submitted nomination material and receiving a presentation on the proposed nomination, voted unanimously to recommend to the Board of Supervisors that the two areas identified in the nomination material be identified as historical resources: That the Board of Supervisors designate the original Knightsen Townsite and Nail Ranch properties as points of historical interest and refer this designation to the County Historical Society for inclusion into the County's Historical Resources Inventory.
