In The Matter Of: RECOGNIZING THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA AND THE MT. DIABLO SILVERADO COUNCIL FOR ITS 100TH ANNIVERSARY

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America was established in 1910 to teach patriotism, courage, self-reliance and kindred values; and

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America today is the largest youth service organization in America, with nearly 3 million members learning responsible citizenship, character development, and self-reliance through participation in a wide range of outdoor activities, educational programs and career-oriented programs in partnership with community organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Mt. Diablo Silverado Council serves five counties, Contra Costa, Lake, Napa, North Alameda and Solano counties and serves approximately 16,000 youth and 5,000 adults; and

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America will celebrate its 100th Anniversary February 8, 2010; and

WHEREAS, a core value of the Boy Scouts of America is service to others; and

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of America is recognizing core scouting values through it's "A Year of Celebration, A Century of Making a Difference," year-long recognition program in honor of the 100th Anniversary; and

WHEREAS, part of the "Year of Celebration" included two weekends of special community service council wide; and

WHEREAS, the Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts and Venturers conducted a food drive in the five counties served by the Mt. Diablo Silverado Council; and

WHEREAS, approximately 300 Eagle Scouts will conduct community service projects totaling and estimated 16,000 hours of service; and

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts will continue the Scoutreach programs for disadvantaged youth in an effort to combat violence and illiteracy; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors hereby recognize the Boy Scouts of America and its 100 years of hard work and dedication to both its members and the community.
