In The Matter Of: California Department of Aging, Older Americans Act Funding

Whereas, the Contra Costa County Employment and Human Services Department provides services funded by the California Department of Aging;

Whereas, due to the enactment of Senate Bill (SB) 853, funding from the Skilled Nursing Facility Quality and Accountability fund will be allocated for the year 2010-2011 only to local long term care ombudsman programs; and,

Whereas, this action results in an increase to funding by \$66,696 from the California Department of Aging to County for the ombudsman program.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved: that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Contra Costa approve and authorize the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute an agreement amendment with the California Department of Aging to increase the payment limit to County by \$66,969 to a new payment limit of \$3,817,442 to provide additional services with no change in the term of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.
