In The Matter Of: Medicare Improvement for Patients and Providers Act (MIPPA) funding.

WHEREAS, the Employment and Human Services Department provides Medicare Improvement for Patients and Providers Act (MIPPA) services to Contra Costa County residents, and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Aging has made carryover funds from fiscal year 2009-2010 to fiscal year 2010-2011 available in the amount of \$569 to the Employment and Human Services Department to enhance the MIPPA program services,

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved: The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute an amendment with the California Department of Aging to increase the payment to County by \$569 to a new payment limit of \$30,641 to enhance Medicare Improvement for Patients and Providers Act services with no change in the term of August 1, 2009 through May 31, 2011.
