

SIDE LETTER

Voluntary Reassignment – Adult Branch Court Deputy Probation Officers

This side letter is by and between the Probation Peace Officers Association of Contra Costa County (PPOACCC) and the County of Contra Costa (County) and is effective the day it is approved by the Board of Supervisors.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Historically, the Adult Branch Court Deputy Probation Officer (ABCDPO) positions were kept separate from the Probation field units and were separately supervised by a Probation Manager. The ABCDPO positions were, and continue to be, paid for and selected by the Superior Court. Due to the need to make structural changes in the Probation Department, these positions have recently been placed under the supervision of a Probation Supervisor, who also supervises a field unit. These ABCDPO positions were placed under the supervision of a Probation Supervisor based solely on the geographical locations of the Superior Courthouses. This change in supervision was not intended to change the reassignment procedures that have historically been applicable to the ABCDPO positions.

AGREEMENT OF THE PARTIES: In order to continue the reassignment process that has historically been applicable to the Adult Branch Court Deputy Probation Officer (ABCDPO) positions, the parties agree that the procedures set forth in subsection (B) (2) Order of Posting of Section 20.2 Posting of Vacancies and Reassignment of the Memorandum of Understanding between Contra Costa County and Probation Peace Officers Association of Contra Costa County (MOU) do not apply to ABCDPO positions. All other provisions of Section 20.2 remain applicable.

The terms of this Side Letter will be incorporated into the next MOU between the County and PPOACCC.


