The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors acting solely in its capacity as the governing board of the County of Contra Costa **RI RESOLVES THAT:** 

Effective upon adoption and continuing to June 30, 2012, and until further order of the Board, the Board adopts the attached program of compensation and benefits for County Elected and Appointed Department Heads, Management Employees, Except Employees, and Unrepresented Employees. Except for Resolution No. 2002/608 (excluding inconsistent provisions concerning the amount of employee contributions for retirement benefits), as amended, this Resolution supersedes all previous resolutions providing compensation and benefits for the employees listed herein, including but not limited to Resolution No. 2011/354.

Unless expressly provided otherwise, this Resolution is subject to the provisions of resolutions providing general and pay equity salary adjustments, Administrative Bulletins, the 1937 County Employees Retirement Act, the County Salary Regulations, and the County Personnel Management Regulations. This Resolution does not authorize compensation and benefits for any employees of the Contra Costa Superior Court or for any management employee who is represented by an employee organization with a Memorandum of Understanding.

Management and Unrepresented employees include employees in Classified, Project, and Exempt classifications. Unless otherwise expressly provided, compensation and benefits under this Resolution are authorized only for permanent and project employees who work full-time or part-time, twenty (20) or more hours per week.

- I. <u>BENEFITS FOR MANAGEMENT, EXEMPT AND UNREPRESENTED EMPLOYEES</u> are provided for those classes listed in **Exhibit A**.
