Margaret served on the Moraga Planning commission for two terms and was elected to and served on the Town Council for two terms. Margaret founded the Hacienda Foundation and served on its board. Both are Kiwanis members and Margaret has served as President. Margaret also served as President of the AAUW for Orinda, Moraga, Lafayette and was Moraga Citizen of the Year in 1987. Both are members of the Moraga Historical Society and worked at the History Center.
