Standards for Administration of the General Assistance Program

WHEREAS, Welfare and Institutions Code section 17000 et seq., requires the Board of Supervisors to adopt standards of aid and care for the indigent and dependent poor of the County, and

WHEREAS, on February 25, 1997, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 97/212 regarding Standards for Administration of the General Assistance Program, and

WHEREAS, on August 10 1999, the Department changed its name from Social Services Department to Employment and Human Department, and

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2009, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 09/459 adding provisions regarding Standards for Administration of the General Assistance Program, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make further revisions to Resolution No. 97/212, in order to update the language of the Resolution, and to require that GA Recipients submit a timely quarterly status report;

that the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors amends the language of Resolution No. 97/212 as follows:

1. All references to Social Services Department are replaced with Employment and Human Services Department; 2. All references to Social Services Director are replaced with Employment and Human Services Director;
3. In Resolution No. 97/212, Part 6, Section 601 Review Eligibility, Paragraph (b), the word Monthly is replaced with the word Quarterly; and
4. In Resolution No. 97/212, Part 7, Section 706 Program Compliance, Paragraph (d), the requirement to submit a timely and complete monthly status report (GA-7) is replaced with a requirement to submit a timely and complete quarterly status report.

All other portions of Resolution No. 97/212, and all portions of Resolution 2009/459 will remain in full force and effect.
