WHEREAS, the Contra Costa County Employment and Human Services Department contracts with and receives funding from the California Department of Aging to provide services for Title III and Title VII programs, and

WHEREAS, the contract amendment (AP-1112-07, Amendment I) re-allocates unspent federal funds from Fiscal Year (FY) 2010-11 to FY 2011-12 and adjusts initial Area Plan allocations for Older Americans Act Title III and Title VII programs, One-Time-Only and Nutrition Service Incentive Program funding for FY 2011-12, and

WHEREAS, the contract amendment increases funds provided to County, and

WHEREAS, the funds will be used to enhance or maintain Title III and Title VII program service levels.
