

## Resolution No. 2012/79



WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors adopted an amendment to the Contra Costa Centre/Pleasant Hill BART Station Area Specific Plan in 1998 establishing policies for pedestrian and bicycle improvements for the portion of Treat Boulevard within the Specific Plan area;

WHEREAS, the Bailey Road Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvement Plan was completed in 2010 and includes recommendations for modifications to the Bailey Road/State Route 4 interchange area to improve safety and mobility for pedestrians and bicyclists;

WHEREAS, the County desires to work with the Bay Point community and interested stakeholders to implement the recommendations of the Bailey Road Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvement Plan for the purpose of fulfilling the community's desire to make Bailey Road a safer and more aesthetically pleasing corridor in the vicinity of its interchange with State Route 4;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has designated the Contra Costa Centre/Pleasant Hill BART Station Area and the Pittsburg/Bay Point BART Station Area as Priority Development Areas for inclusion in the Association of Bay Area Government's (ABAG) FOCUS land use planning program.

WHEREAS, ABAG has issued a "call for projects" for the FY 2012/13 to fund certain transportation planning activities of local jurisdictions in Priority Development Areas;

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors is eligible to receive Federal and/or State funding for certain transportation planning activities, through ABAG and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission;

WHEREAS, Contra Costa County wishes to delegate authorization to execute these agreements and any amendments thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and directs the Conservation and Development Department Director, or designee, to complete and deliver ABAG Technical Assistance Grant Applications to ABAG for funds up to \$60,000 per application for FY 2012/13 for the purpose of developing the Contra Costa Centre Treat Boulevard/I-680 Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan, and beginning project development work on the Bailey Road Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Plan.
