WHEREAS, the Library was nominated and selected to receive the coveted Institute of Museum and Library Services National Medal for its many achievements in bringing the library to the community, given to only five libraries and five museums each year; and

WHEREAS, the Library was honored to receive the National Medal at a White House Ceremony on November 14, 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors does hereby recognize the Contra Costa County Library and its talented and innovative staff for the outstanding work it is doing in service to the community, and extends its proud congratulations for receiving the nation's highest honor of the Institute of Museum and Library Services National Medal.
