**ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WITH GROSS WEIGHT
EXCEEDING 14,000 POUNDS ON MARSH CREEK ROAD BETWEEN
BYRON HIGHWAY/STATE ROUTE 4 AND BIXLER ROAD**

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to prohibit commercial vehicles with a gross weight exceeding 14,000 pounds from traveling on Marsh Creek Road, between its intersection with Byron Highway/State Route 4, and its intersection with Bixler Road, because that section of roadway cannot support those commercial vehicles. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Vehicle Code section 35717 and County Ordinance Code sections 46-2.002 and 46-2.012.

Section 2. Traffic Ordinance. Commercial vehicles exceeding a maximum gross weight of 14,000 pounds are prohibited at all times on Marsh Creek Road (Road No. 8943), between the intersection of Marsh Creek Road and Byron Highway/State Route 4, and the intersection of Marsh Creek Road and Bixler Road (Road No. 9163A), in the Discovery Bay area, eastern Contra Costa County.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after passage, and within 15 days of passage, this ordinance shall be published once with the names of the supervisors voting for and against it in the Contra Costa Times, a newspaper published in this County.
