This has hurt our district financially, in addition to rising operation costs.

The Cemetery District continues to run efficiently, and I am delighted to be a part of this District; we have three of the most reliable, conscientious Trustees, Primo E. Facchini, Nancy Flood, and Carolyn Thiessen.

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BOARD OF TRUSTEES' ANNUAL REPORT

July 1, 2012 - June 30, 2013

During this past fiscal year there were 23 full casket in-ground interments, 12 cremation interments and 1 urn placed into the niches at the Lafayette Cemetery plus the pre-need sale of 19 full casket in-ground sites, 1 cremation site and 9 niches. In the Alamo Cemetery there were 6 full casket in-ground interments, 11 cremations and 8 urns placed into the niches plus the pre-need sale of 25 niches were sold in Alamo. The Lafayette Cemetery has only 400 interment sites and 168 niches for sale. The Alamo Cemetery still has 342 above ground niches for sale. No full casket in-ground interment sites are available in Alamo. Income generated by the above is not sufficient to maintaining the operating costs.

Our grounds keepers have been maintaining both cemeteries, as well as the opening / closing for all interments. They have replaced 6 retaining walls. There were many trips to Contra Costa Transfer Station at a cost of \$5356. Here are some of the expenses associated with running our District; Truck repairs \$8847. Tractor repairs \$4602. Workers Compensation & Property Insurance \$9385. Liners \$8150. New Trees \$4583. Gardelle Construction has been maintaining the lawns by mowing, blowing, grading and weed eating, plus the cost of fertilization and pre-emergence for an annual cost of \$12,000. This are just some of our expenses.

Again, costs are up for items used to keep the District running smoothly, including benefits, medical / dental, garbage, liners, utilities, supplies, etc. Operating a public cemetery is very much different than operating a private cemetery. This past year the District spent \$2033 to repurchase 3 full casket sites. The costs associated with funerals / burials are extremely expensive; more and more we are seeing persons choosing cremation and then taking home their loved one's urn.

As of June 2013, the District has \$434,503 in its Endowment Fund and \$12,810 in LAIF (Local Agency Investment Fund). Actual annual operating budget was \$372,115. Total tax revenue from 2012-13 F/Y was \$206,708.
