SUBJECT: Establish speed limits on Castro Ranch Road (Road No. 1461), El Sobrante area.

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors RESOLVES that:

On the basis of an engineering and traffic survey and recommendations thereon by the County Public Works Department's Transportation Division, and pursuant to County Ordinance Code Sections 46-2.002 - 46-2.012, the following traffic regulation is established (and other action taken, as indicated):

Pursuant to Section 22358 and Section 627 of the California Vehicle Code, no vehicle shall travel in excess of 35 miles per hour on Castro Ranch Road (Road No. 1461), beginning at Alhambra Valley Road (Road No. 1481) and extending southerly to the Richmond City Limit;

THENCE, no vehicle shall travel in excess of 35 miles per hour on that portion of Castro Ranch Road (Road No. 1461), beginning at Olinda Road (Road No. 1664A) and extending southerly to the intersection of San Pablo Dam Road (Road No. 0961D), El Sobrante.

Traffic Resolution No. 1981/2682 pertaining to the speed limit on Castro Ranch Road is hereby rescinded.
