Whereas, Marechal Duncan started volunteering in Lafayette 60 years ago when he first moved to the area with his wife Doris, and he has not slowed down; and

Whereas, Marechal's volunteer efforts included, when his four children were little, serving as a Boy Scout Leader for 20 years and as a LMYA basketball coach. He also volunteered as the Co-chair of the Lafayette Sesquicentennial Celebration in 1998; and

Whereas, Marechal currently serves as the Vice President of the Lafayette Historical Society, and is on the Lafayette Community Foundation's Liaison Committee for Seniors, where he serves as Co-chair for the annual Senior Symposium; and

Whereas, Marechal was born in Quincy, Massachusetts, in 1922, and soon after he moved to San Diego with his family; he joined the Navy in 1940. Upon his return from the Navy, he earned his Bachelor of Science Degree from UC Berkeley and a few years later received a Master's Degree from Pepperdine University; and

WHEREAS, Marechal and his wife Doris have become an integral part of the Lafayette community, keeping busy with their grandchildren and showing no sign of slowing down. Marechal is always telling everyone, "Today's news is tomorrow's history."

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County does hereby honor and thank Marechal Duncan for his many years of dedication and service to Lafayette.
