Re: Appointment Recommendation to the Hazardous Materials Commission

The Hazardous Materials Commission was established in 1986 to advise the Board, County Staff and the mayor's council members, and staffs of the cities within the County, on issues related to the development, approval and administration of the County Hazardous Waste Management Plan. Specifically, the Board charged the Commission with drafting a Hazardous Materials Storage and Transportation Plan and Ordinance, coordinating the implementation of the Hazardous Materials Release Response Plan and inventory program, and to analyze and develop recommendations regarding hazards materials issues with consideration to broad public input, and report back to the Board on Board referrals.

The bylaws of the Commission provide that the Environmental Seat # 2 Alternate be nominated by an environmental organization, but that no particular environmental organization will have an exclusive right to nominate an individual to this seat and therefore, which environmental organization is represented on the Hazardous Materials Commission rests with the Internal Operations Committee and ultimately the Board of Supervisors This seat has been vacant since 2010 and the Commission has solicited applications for the seat many times since then (see attached material).

The Martinez Environmental Organization nominated Peter Dragovich for this seat in January, 2015. Their letter of nomination and Mr. Dragovich's application are attached. The Operations Committee of the Commission interviewed Mr. Dragovich on March 13, 2015 and unanimously recommended that the full Commission recommend his appointment by the Board of Supervisors. The full Commission reviewed the Operations Committee recommendation on March 26, 2015 and voted unanimously 8 – 0 to recommend his appointment by the Board of Supervisors. The term of this seat expires on December 31, 2015.

The Martinez Environmental Group (MEG) is pleased to nominate Peter Dragovich as an applicant for the vacant Environmental Organization Seat #2 - Alternate on the Contra Costa County Hazardous Materials Commission.

MEG believes Mr. Dragovich has a strong skill set for this position with over 25 years of experience in local government, combined with his commitment to preserving our natural environment. Prior to his retirement from the City of Concord he held numerous responsibilities for environmental programs. He established the first household hazardous waste collection program for the City of Concord and managed franchises for Concord including solid waste and recycling.

Mr. Dragovich has been with MEG since the formation of our organization in March 2014, contributing to various projects including Alhambra Hills preservation, review of the Philips 66 Rodeo Propane Recovery and Santa Maria (Nipomo) rail spur expansion projects, the Valero Crude by Rail project in Benicia, Shell GHG Reduction Project in Martinez, Chevron Refinery Richmond expansion, crude-by-rail transiting through the City of Martinez, Acme Fill post-closure permit review, Kinder Morgan BAAQMD permitting, and comments to state legislators on SB 1319 and AB 380. He drafted a comprehensive memo and resolution about crude-by-rail that MEG submitted to the City of Martinez Public Safety Subcommittee, which formed the basis of a resolution passed by the City Council on rail safety. He has been active in community education efforts, making a presentation at a public forum on Crude by Rail sponsored by MEG, addressing the City of Martinez City Council and Public Safety Subcommittee on environmental issues and providing support for Healing Walks sponsored by Idle No More, an indigenous First Nations group concerned with protection of the environment.

I am a volunteer member of the Martinez Environmental Group (MEG) which has nominated me to apply for the vacant Environmental Organization Seat #2 - Alternate.

I have been a Martinez resident for 25 years. I retired in 2008 after working 20 years for the City of Concord, initially as a city planner, then as Assistant to the City Manager and from 2001-08 as Department Head for Concord's City Management Department under City Manager Ed James. I have attended Hazardous Materials Commission and Commission Committee meetings over the past year and believe my interests and background would assist the Commission further its mission.

Responsibility areas with the City of Concord included:
