**ABOLISHING POSITIONS WITHIN THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE RELATED TO THE TERMINATION OF THE
POLICE SERVICES CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF OAKLEY**

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2015 the City Council of the City of Oakley voted to discontinue a contract with the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office for the provision of law enforcement services to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff-Coroner has requested approval of the Board of Supervisors to terminate the Police Services Contract with the City of Oakley effective May 7, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff-Coroner has identified positions within the Sheriff's Office that will no longer be required once the Police Services Contract with the City of Oakley has been terminated; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff-Coroner intends to reassign personnel from the City of Oakley to vacant positions within the Sheriff's Office once the Police Services Contract with the City of Oakley has been terminated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The positions set forth in Attachment A to this Resolution shall be abolished and the employees reassigned to vacant positions within the Office of the Sheriff effective May 7, 2015.
