Grantee shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Grantor and its governing body, parent corporations, affiliates and subsidiaries, officers, agents, and employees from and against all claims, losses, actions, demands, damages, costs, expenses (including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs) (collectively, "Claims") which arise from or are connected with Grantee's activities, or the entry on, occupancy or use of, the Premises by Grantee or Grantee's Representatives under this Temporary Permit for Ingress and Egress, including, but not limited to, Claims arising out of (i) injury to or death of persons, including, but not limited to, employees of Grantee or its Contractors or Agents; (ii) injury to property or other interest of Grantor and (iii) violation of any applicable federal, state, or local laws, statutes, regulations, or ordinances by Grantee or Grantee's contractors or agents, to the extent such Claims do not arise from the negligence or willful misconduct of Grantor.

It is further understood and agreed that permission to do the work and perform the acts stated herein shall remain in force and effect only until the completion of construction, or December 31, 2015, whichever occurs first. All rights hereunder shall cease when said work has been completed or by December 31, 2015, whichever occurs first.
