

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-15

REVERSION TO ACREAGE BY MAP

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows (omitting the parenthetical footnotes from the official text of the enacted or amended provisions of the County Ordinance Code):

SECTION I. SUMMARY. Ordinance No. 2015-06, adopted by the Board of Supervisors on April 14, 2015, amended local procedures for reversion to acreage proceedings. Ordinance No. 2015-06 designated the Board of Supervisors as the hearing body for all reversion to acreage proceedings and removed the Planning Commission's authority to approve and disapprove reversion maps. Ordinance Code Chapter 924-4 includes procedures that are inconsistent with Ordinance No. 2015-06. This ordinance repeals Ordinance Code Chapter 924-4.

SECTION II. Chapter 924-4 of the County Ordinance Code is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after passage, and within 15 days after passage shall be published once with the names of supervisors voting for or against it in the Contra Costa Times, a newspaper published in this County.
