In the Matter of Adjusting the Salary Step of an Incumbent in the Classification of EHS Division Manager

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa County Salary Regulations state that "Any employee who is appointed to a position of a class allocated to a higher salary range than the class he previously occupied shall receive the salary in the new salary range which is next higher than the rate he was receiving before promotion," and

WHEREAS, the incumbent in the EHS Division Manager position #4969 was promoted to that position on May 7, 2015 and placed at step 6 according to the salary regulations rule on promotion; and

WHEREAS, the incumbent in this position has the largest span of control within the largest division of the Department; and

WHEREAS, as recommended by the appointing authority, there is a need to recognize and compensate this employee accordingly by placing her at step 7 of the salary range for the EHS Division Manager,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the incumbent in position #4969 shall be moved from step 6 to step 7 of the salary range for the EHS Division Manager, effective May 7, 2015.
