APPLICATION TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CalRecycle) AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE USED OIL PAYMENT PROGRAM

The Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County RESOLVES that:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code § 48690 the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board, has established the Used Oil Payment Program (OPP) to make payments to qualifying jurisdictions for implementation of their used oil programs; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the administration of the Used Oil Payment Program; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering the Used Oil Payment Program require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the Used Oil Payment Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors authorizes the submittal of a Used Oil Payment Program application to CalRecycle; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Conservation & Development, or his/her designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the Contra Costa County all documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, annual reports including itemized expenditures and any amendments necessary to secure said payments to support our Used Oil Collection Program serving the unincorporated County area; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization is effective until rescinded by the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors.
