





2.	<b>Project Description:</b> The purpose of this Project is to install landscape improvements (approximately 1,400 LF) along section of the Iron Horse Corridor at Hookston Station, between Hookston Road and Mayhew Way in the Pleasant area.									
	The Project consists of installing irrigation piping systems, tree and shrubbery plantings, and other landscaping improvements. The Project also includes installing approximately 1,000 linear feet of asphalt concrete on an existing earthen path that roughly parallels this section of the Iron Horse Trail for alternative pedestrian use. Pedestrians will be able to use the alternative pedestrian paved path, allowing bicycles to utilize the adjacent Iron Horse Trail.									
	Since the Project area was previously occupied by Southern Pacific Railroad until 1978 and is an active SLIC (Spills, Leaks, Investigations and Cleanup) case currently under the oversight of the Regional Water Quality Control Board, the County hired ENGEO, Inc. to conduct soil analysis, prepare a Remedial Investigation Report (Report), and develop a Work Plan in support of the Project. Contra Costa County Health Services (CCCHS) reviewed and approved the Report and Work Plan. Pursuant to the Report and Work Plan, during construction appropriate Best Management Practices (BMPs) will be implemented for the Project including soil stockpile management and testing, construction dust management, and other recommendations identified in the Report and Work Plan.
