RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF CONTRA COSTA APPROVING, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING EXECUTION OF A JOINT EXERCISE OF POWERS AGREEMENT RELATING TO THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC FINANCE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the County of Contra Costa ("County"), hereby requests to become an Additional Member of the California Public Finance Authority ("Authority") pursuant to Section 12 of the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement Relating to the Authority, dated as of May 12, 2015 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, there is now before the Board of Supervisors the form of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County proposes to participate in the Authority finance programs and desires that certain projects to be located within the County be financed pursuant to the Authority and it is in the public interest and for the public benefit that the County do so; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement has been filed with the County Clerk, and the members of the Board of Supervisors, with the assistance of its County staff, have reviewed said document.

Section 1. The Agreement is hereby approved and the County Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Agreement, with such changes, insertions and omissions as may be approved by the Board of Supervisors, and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to affix the County's seal to the Agreement and attest thereto.

Section 2. The County Administrator, the County Clerk and all other proper officers and officials of the County are hereby authorized and directed to execute such other agreements, documents and certificates, and to perform such other acts and deeds, as may be necessary or convenient to effect the purposes of this Resolution and the transactions herein authorized.
