Permission is hereby granted to Contra Costa County, its contractors and their authorized agents, to enter and bring the necessary workers, tools and equipment on the property located at Kirker Pass Road in Concord identified as a portion of Assessor Parcel Number 118-050-009 for the purpose of performing geotechnical surveys. These survey activities are required for the Kirker Pass Road Northbound Truck Lanes Project.

Geotechnical Surveys

Two borings will be drilled and accessed at the approximate locations shown on the attached map. The borings will be advanced with a track-mounted drill rig, using rotary wash or hollow stem drilling method to a maximum depth of 40 feet and approximately 6 to 8 inches in diameter. The main purpose is to determine the bedrock depths.

The track-mounted drill rig typically has a footprint of 20 by 10 feet. During operation, the height is approximately 30 feet (mast up). In addition to the drill rig, a water/support truck and a pick-up truck are also anticipated. The crew generally consists of a field engineer, a driller, and a driller's helper. The field investigation will be conducted under the supervision of our field engineer who logs the test borings and prepares the samples for subsequent laboratory testing and evaluation. Drilling operation is generally from 8am till dusk.

The drilling will be completed in approximately two days. The drilling spoils and soil cuttings will be spread onsite and upon completion, boreholes will be backfilled with cement-bentonite grout and the surface area will be restored to its original condition.

In accordance with State law, Underground Service Alert (USA) will be notified at least 48 business hours prior to commencing field operations. During drilling operation, minimum personal protective equipment including hard hat, eye protection, work boots with safety toe and defined heel, and safety vest with reflective strip will be required. Best Management Practices will be employed to maintain a clean and safe work area.

It is understood and agreed that Contra Costa County will leave the premises in a clean, orderly condition and will repair, replace, or compensate for any existing improvements that may have been disturbed or removed during the course of the work.



Contra Costa County will provide seventy-two (72) hours notice to the owner/operator of the property prior to entry upon the property. Property owner will provide access at the location of entry and closing gates for access.

These survey activities are required for the Kirker Pass Road Northbound Truck Lanes Project.

Geotechnical Surveys

Two borings (RW1 and RW2) will be drilled approximately 100' deep at the locations shown on the attached map. Equipment to be used consists of a track mounted drill rig, water truck and support truck. All vehicles are restricted to the "Cell Site" gravel road and or the existing fire guard, including vehicle turn around maneuvers, no access on the grass is allowed. All vehicles are required to carry fire extinguishers. Smoking is prohibited.

The duration for the drilling operation will be approximately seven (7) consecutive working days for each boring for approximately 14 working days. An additional five (5) weeks after is required for field work, for a total of approximately seven (7) weeks.

A "down hole" video will be taken of the rock bedding and Boring RW1 converted to an inclinometer casing to allow stability measurements to be taken in the future. The hole will be capped and locked with a cylindrical or square metal cap. The duration of the permit for five (5) years is to allow one-two (1-2) visits per year to take inclinometer measurements after the initial drilling operation is completed through the estimated end of construction.

It is understood and agreed that Contra Costa County will leave the premises in a clean, orderly condition and will repair, replace, or compensate for any existing improvements that may have been disturbed or removed during the course of the work.

It is further understood and agreed that permission to do the work and perform the acts stated herein shall remain in force and effect June 24, 2014 through December 31, 2019. Contra Costa County will provide seventy-two (72) hours notice to the owner/operator of the property prior to entry upon the property. Property owner will provide location of entry and closing gates for access.


