On election night it was discovered that the total number of ballots cast from the polling places (M100 scanners) were aggregating the total number of cards scanned (Top Two Cards plus Presidential Cards) and reporting that as the total number of ballots cast.

After Election Night all ballots from the polling places were rerun on our central count tabulators (M650) and the discrepancy was resolved.
