



Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project: The project area is badly deteriorated and poses safety hazards to pedestrians and vehicles. The purpose of the project is to repair/replace asphalt parking lots, curb, sidewalk, and driveway. The project consists of excavating and replacing sidewalk and asphalt, applying road surface treatment, restriping, and adjusting signs.									
A certified arborist recommended that approximately twelve (12) ornamental (carob) trees be removed, after determining they would most likely have significant health issues and would be unstable if kept after sidewalks were repaired. If trees are removed during nesting bird season (February 15-August 31), a biologist will conduct a nesting bird survey prior to tree removal. Other trees and shrubbery, in the project area, may need trimming. In order to minimize damage to any nearby trees, any roots exposed during excavation will be cut cleanly.									
Vehicles will be diverted around the project area during construction activities. Real Property transactions, including right-of-way, may be necessary in support of this Project.
