Areas that are outside the Urban Limit Line, but surrounded on four sides by areas that are inside the ULL, or surrounded on 3 sides where the fourth side is along the coastline.

## Two "Islands" near East Richmond Heights were created in 2004



Passed by voters in 2004, Measure J called for the Board of Supervisors to adjust the ULL boundary and make it co-terminus or coincident with the city where it intruded inside incorporated city limits.

Approved October 5, 2005, (County File: GP\#04-0005) The Urban Limit Line was adjusted, moving all of incorporated Richmond inside the ULL. This left an 'island' of unincorporated land outside the ULL.

## This "Island" in Alhambra Valley near Martinez was created in 2006

Approved by voters on Nov 7, 2006, Measure L: (Coun File: GP\#06-0001) Adjusted the ULL moving Subdivision \#6443 Alhambra Valley Estates and Subdivision \#7609 Creekside Oak Estates inside the ULL. This was in conjunction with part of the city along the waterfront being placed outside the ULL.

In 2012 LAFCO approved LAFCO 11-07, annexing Subdivision \#6443 along with Subdivision \#7091 Stonehurst and Subdivision \#7238 Valley Orchard, into the city of Martinez.
