Attachment to CCC Application for Re-Appointment to East Bay Regional Park District Park Advisory Committee

I am seeking re-appointment to the EBRPD Park Advisory Committee on behalf of the Contra Costa Board of Supervisors. I have served the County in this position since 2012 and can serve through the end of 2018 under the Park District's eight year term limits for PAC membership. I previously served on the PAC as an appointee of former Park District Director Ted Radke, from 2001 to 2009, and have now served an additional five years as an appointee of the CC Board of Supervisors. I have an excellent attendance record on the Committee and I take every opportunity to dialog with members of the Board of Supervisors on Contra Costa issues pertaining to the Park District.

I am a third generation Contra Costan, a lifelong user of the regional parks, my wife and I were married in Tilden Park 30 years ago, I have served 13 years on the PAC, and I have explored most of the District's 66 regional parks. My wife and I regularly hike District park and regional trails. I have served the District as an EBRPD "park ambassador" since 2005. Along with my wife and two college age children, we were the Park District's first "ambassador family," each of us having received ambassador training. As volunteer Park Ambassadors we regularly attend community events (fairs, festivals, public and private events) and man a Park District table, distributing brochures and answering questions people have on the parks and trails. My wife and I are members of the Regional Parks Foundation, and through the Foundation we annually support five summer "camperships", a program designed to send inner city kids to Park District outdoor camps at little to no cost to their parents.

I was a Park District spokesperson on the campaign in support of bond Measure WW. On the PAC I have made a central focus of my involvement with Park District Board members and management the District's adherence to funding the Contra Costa park and trail projects designated for funding through Measure WW. I will be honored and appreciative of re-appointment to the PAC and hope to continue this work with the Park District on behalf of Contra Costa.
