WHEREAS, the Resource Family Approval (RFA) Program is a new unified, family-friendly and child-centered caregiver approval process created to replace multiple processes; and WHEREAS, it is a streamline set of standards for resource family approval which allows safety, permanence and well-being of the children who have been victims of child abuse an neglect; and WHEREAS, it decreases the length of time for each child to obtain permanency; and WHEREAS, California Department of Social Services (CDSS) will provide legal consultation and psychosocial assessment which are necessary to expedite the delivery of services to children and non-minor dependents who reside or may reside in an approved resource family home.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved: The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors approve and authorized the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee to execute a non-financial contract with the California Department of Social Services to provide legal services and psychological assessments associated with the Resource Family Approval Program for the period January 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019.
