I have held a commercial pilot rating for over thirty years. In the 1980s I worked part-time as a flight instructor and am very familiar with aircraft operating procedures and regulations. I have belonged to flying clubs at Buchanan Field in the past, and I am a current member of the Northern California Soaring Association at the Byron Airport which I believe to be the only organization offering flight instruction at Byron. I am also a member of the Northern California Aerobatic Club. I have recently met with members of the AAC to help them address noise complaints in the Brentwood area believed to be caused by aircraft practicing aerobatics.

I was raised in Pleasant Hill approximately four miles from Buchanan Field. I attended Mount Diablo Unified School District schools graduating from College Park High School in 1968. I obtained a BS in Conservation from UC Berkeley and a MA in Marine Biology from San Francisco State University. I worked primarily as a biologist for UC Berkeley, UC San Francisco, UC Santa Barbara, Stanford University, California Fish & Game, National Oceanographic and Atmospheric Administration and the National Park Service. I retired from Point Reyes National Seashore in 2012 after a twenty year career with the Federal Government. I have lived the majority of my life in Contra Costa County and have been the coowner of a house in Point Richmond since 1993. I have a good understanding of the issues facing decision makers in West County as well as Central County where I grew-up.


