Defining HCP and NCCP

- <u>HCP</u> (Habitat Conservation Plan): A <u>federally</u>-approved mitigation plan to conserve and permit impacts to endangered species.
- <u>NCCP</u> (Natural Community Conservation Plan): Similar to HCP, but approved by the <u>State</u>. Has a higher standard for conservation. Plan must contribute to the recovery of species.
- The East Contra Costa County HCP/NCCP enables the County, the Cities of Brentwood, Clayton, Oakley and Pittsburg, EBRPD and Flood Control to control species permitting for their jurisdiction until 2037.





Figure 1 East Contra Costa County Habitat Conservation Plan Inventory Area



Milestones

2000/2001Local agencies initiate HCP/NCCP planning process

- October 10, 2006 Final HCP/NCCP & EIR/EIS released
- August 6, 2007Approval by all local, state & federal agencies
- January 15, 2008 HCP/NCCP Implementing Ordinances take effect
- May 2012U.S. Army Corps of Engineers approves Regional General
Permit that is a companion to the HCP/NCCP
- 2017 10 Year Anniversary of the HCP/NCCP's approval



Figure 3b. Location of Covered Projects to-date (2008-2016)







East Contra Costa County Habitat Conservancy Preserve System Lands as of 07/24/2017






