Excellent: 86 to 100

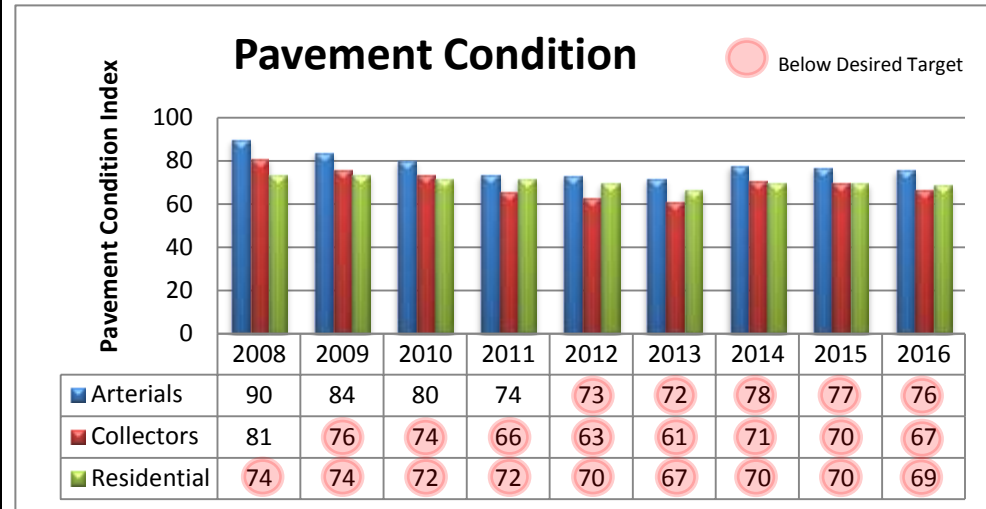
Good: 75 to 85

Status



Analysis

The County's Pavement Condition Index continues its steady decline. The storms of 2016/2017 will further deteriorate the roads. We are already seeing the visual evidence of the unraveling of roads that we have not been able to apply preventative surface treatments to. The Board of Supervisors adopted a support position for AB1 that would provide a transportation funding fix.

Actions

- Seek additional "new" funding for pavement preservation
- Continue to apply for grants
- Use innovative pavement rehabilitation methods such as cold in-place recycling, micro-surfacing, etc.
- Work through CEAC Statewide Needs Assessment efforts to educate legislators on the need to fix the declining buying power of gas tax. Push for indexing gas tax to CPI or other price index.
- Issue identified in legislative platform for maintenance funding.
- Recommend the Board of Supervisors support SB1.
