WHEREAS, the community holds the responsibility to ensure that mental health services are available to all residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the month of May 2018 as “Mental Health Awareness Month” in Contra Costa County and encourages all residents to promote the restoration of mental wellness in the community.
