**RESOLUTION NO. 2018/4467**  
**Supervisorial District III**

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SUBJECT: Establish speed limits on Byron Highway (Road No. 8861, 8851D and 9621),  
Knightsen/Byron area.

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors RESOLVES that:

On the basis of an engineering and traffic survey and recommendations by the County Public Works Department's Transportation Engineering Division, and pursuant to County Ordinance Code Sections 46-2.002 – 46-2.012, the following traffic regulation is established (and other action taken, as indicated):

Pursuant to Section 22358(a) and Section 627 of the California Vehicle Code, no vehicle shall travel in excess of 45 miles per hour on that portion of Byron Highway (Road No. 8861 and 8851D), beginning at Delta Road (Road No. 8263) and extending southerly to Vincent Drive (Private Road);

THENCE, no vehicle shall travel in excess of 50 miles per hour on that portion of Byron Highway (Road No. 8851D), beginning at Vincent Drive (Private Road) and extending southerly to Brentwood Boulevard (Road No. 8761);

THENCE, no vehicle shall travel in excess of 55 miles per hour on that portion of Byron Highway (Road No. 8851D), beginning at Brentwood Boulevard (Road No. 8761) and extending southerly to Marsh Creek Road (Road No. 3971A);

THENCE, no vehicle shall travel in excess of 45 miles per hour on that portion of Byron Highway (Road No. 9621), beginning at State Route 4 and extending southerly to Hoffman Lane (Road No. 8543);

THENCE, no vehicle shall travel in excess of 35 miles per hour on that portion of Byron Highway (Road No. 9621), beginning at Hoffman Lane and extending southerly 2900 feet south of Camino Diablo (Road No. 7941);

THENCE, no vehicle shall travel in excess of 50 miles per hour on that portion of Byron Highway (Road No. 9621), beginning 2900 feet south of Camino Diablo (Road No. 7941) and extending southerly to the Alameda County line.

Traffic Resolution 1992/3504, pertaining to speed limits on Byron Highway, is hereby rescinded.
