Real Property transactions, including right-of-way acquisition may be necessary in support of this activity.

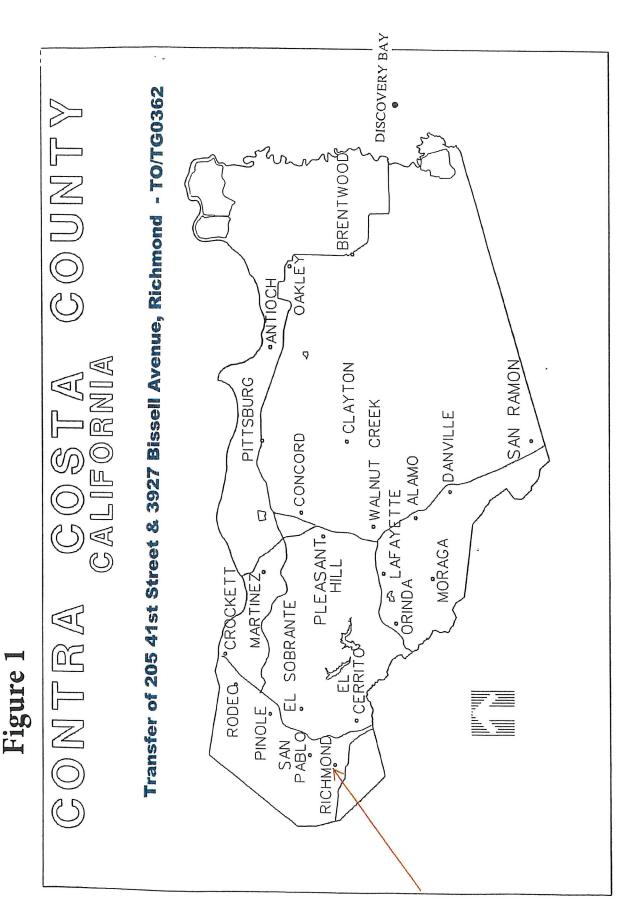

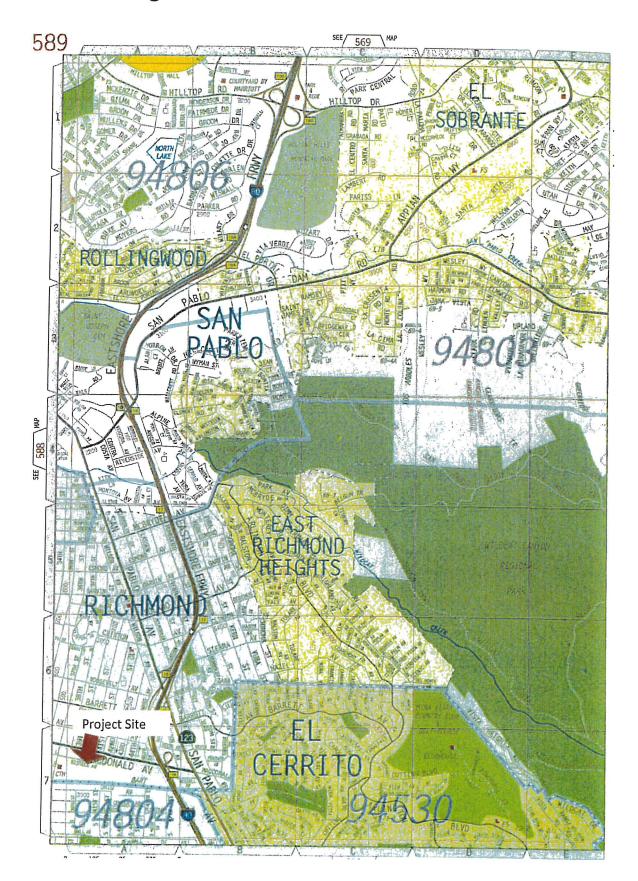
