In the Matter of Adopting the Health Officer Regulations for Sewage Collection and Disposal:

WHEREAS, on this date the Board adopted Ordinance No. 2018-25 to amend Chapter 420-6 of the Ordinance Code, which establishes requirements for sewage collection and disposal; and

WHEREAS, the health officer has proposed Regulations for Sewage Collection and Disposal (“Regulations”) to make more detailed and specific the provisions of Chapter 420-6 of the Ordinance Code; and

WHEREAS, the Regulations are necessary to set forth standards and specifications for the siting, design and construction of onsite wastewater treatment systems, the review of building permit applications and subdivision maps, the design, installation and use of sewage collection systems, the abandonment of sewage disposal systems and sewage collection systems, and septic tank toilet cleaners; and

WHEREAS, the Regulations are intended to protect public health and safety and the environment by preventing the creation of health hazards, nuisance conditions and degradation of surface and ground water quality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Regulations are hereby adopted and shall take effect upon the effective date of Ordinance No. 2018-25.
