

Project Description: Contra Costa County Public Works Department proposes to provide systemic safety improvements to deter speeding along this stretch of the roadway and as such improve driver safety. The improvements include installation of rumble strips and delineators along the center of the road, reconstruction of the median, upgrades and replacement of signage for improved visibility, installation of speed advisory signs, and a surface overlay to preserve the integrity of the roadway (Figures 3 – 7). Project construction is expected to occur in spring 2020 and take approximately 30 working days to complete.


