

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-22

ASSESSMENT APPEALS BOARD FEES

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows (omitting the parenthetical footnotes from the official text of the enacted or amended provisions of the County Ordinance Code):

SECTION I. SUMMARY. This ordinance amends Section 26-10.410 of the County Ordinance Code to authorize the board of supervisors to establish assessment appeals board fees for filing and processing an application for changed assessment and for the preparation of written findings of fact in the assessment appeals board’s fee schedule.

SECTION II. Section 26-10.410 of the County Ordinance Code is amended to read:

26-10.410 Fees.

- (a) The fee for filing and processing an application for changed assessment shall be an amount established by the board of supervisors in the assessment appeals board’s fee schedule.
- (b) The fee for the preparation of written findings of fact shall be an amount established by the board of supervisors in the assessment appeals board’s fee schedule. (Ords. 2019-22 § 2, 2011-12 § 2).

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after passage, and within 15 days after passage shall be published once with the names of supervisors voting for or against it in the East Bay Times, a newspaper published in this County.
