In the matter of recognizing the contributions of Donald L. Bouchet for his extraordinary service to the citizens of Contra Costa County and to the Office of the County Treasurer-Tax Collector.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors established the Treasury Oversight Committee in April of 1995 per California Government Code 27131 (*Amended in 2004*);

WHEREAS, the responsibilities of the Committee were to:

- Annually review the County's Investment Policy and cause an annual audit to be conducted to determine the county treasurer's compliance with the Policy;
- Quarterly monitor the County Investment Pool's performance and report on the Pool's performance to the Board of Supervisors;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors set the terms for members of the Committee at four years, and made appointments to the Committee for the first time on April 15, 1996.

WHEREAS, Mr. Bouchet was appointed by the Board of Supervisors as one of the first appointees to serve on the Committee;

WHEREAS, Mr. Bouchet was appointed to represent the Board of Supervisors on the Committee, and occupied this position since its inception;

WHEREAS, Mr. Bouchet served on the Committee for more than 23 years, some of which he also served as the Committee chair or vice chair;

WHEREAS, Mr. Bouchet regularly participated in Committee meetings and contributed significantly to the carrying out of its responsibilities;

WHEREAS, Mr. Bouchet resigned from the Treasury Oversight Committee on September 20 of 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Contra Costa County does hereby recognize and commend Donald L. Bouchet for his extraordinary service to the County and to the Office of the County Treasurer-Tax Collector.
