WHEREAS, the California Department of Education (CDE) provides funding to reimburse a portion of the childcare costs incurred by CalWORKS Stage 2 participants through their participation in the CalWORKS program, WHEREAS, on July 16, 2020 the department was notified by the State that additional revenue for fiscal year 2018-19 was due to the department, WHEREAS, after the California Department of Education's Audits and Investigations Division reviewed the department's FY 2018-19 audit report, they determined that the report materially meets CDE's reporting requirements and determined the amount of net reimbursable program costs, WHEREAS, according to their audit, the department was under-reimbursed for the services the department rendered during 2018-19 year, and WHEREAS, this amendment is to accept the reimbursement of funds from CDE.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved: The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the Employment & Human Services Department Director, or designee, to execute a revenue agreement amendment with California Department of Education, to increase the payment limit by \$701,623 to a new limit not to exceed \$7,861,800 for childcare and development programs (CalWORKS Stage 2) with no change to period July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019.
