Hi Julie

I called the county and they said to submit questions to the board I need to email you. I hope this is correct.

1. We have a small business in Brentwood and it is at the Sand Creek Business Center. Our office has 6 employees. While the new order says office business can return, does this mean that we can have our employees come back to the office provided we provide the accommodations in the order? Currently they can telecommute but we do need to come together sometimes and I would like the rules on this clearer.
2. Also as a business our sales are down the last couple of months by half. We have applied to SBA for EIDL and PPP. We had notified our property manager that per our contract we have a force majeure clause where every day we can't pay we get a day extra to pay. However, it seems unfair that the civil authority says we cannot use an office space but we still need to pay for it. How does the board plan to address this and are they going to offer help to businesses on whether they need to pay for a property usage we are not allowed to use?

Also as a citizen I would like to submit my own comment:

1. I am repeatedly hearing that the county needs to meet a testing threshold and get asymptomatic and symptomatic people to test more than once. How often do asymptomatic people need to test to help meet this threshold?
