Good afternoon Julie -

I know this is a late add but thought I'd send in the following questions just the same:

- 1. With the latest CDPH guidance on private gatherings, will the County be providing interpretive guidance on how to correlate their social bubble / social gathering construct with the State's private gathering construct?
- 2. With the publishing of HO-COVID19-28, County and State restrictions on business activities became aligned, which is very helpful. However, many of the State's industry-specific restrictions (capacity percentages and such) have been written prior to the implementation of the new 'tier' system. Should we move into the orange tier in the next few weeks, does the County have any insight on whether the State "blueprint" guidelines will overrule the older industry-specific guidelines? For example, if moving from red tier to orange tier results in a shift from 25% capacity to 50% capacity but the industry guidance drafted this past summer specifically states 25% capacity, do we follow the newer guidance? It might be a better question for the CDPH but thought I'd ask.
