

TRANSCRIPT FOR THE TEFRA HEARING

May 3, 2021 10:30 a.m.

This noticed public hearing is required by the federal Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act (TEFRA), Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”). The hearing is on the proposed issuance by the California Municipal Finance Authority of tax-exempt revenue bonds in an amount not to exceed seven hundred three million, seven hundred thousand dollars (\$703,700,000). A portion of the proceeds of the bonds, in an amount not to exceed seventy million, four hundred thousand (\$70,400,000) will be used to finance and refinance certain capital projects at the following locations:


- Keller Canyon Landfill, 901 Bailey Road, Pittsburg, CA 94565
- Allied Waste Services of Contra Costa County, 441 N. Buchanan Cir, Pacheco, CA 94553
- West Contra Costa Sanitary Landfill & Bay Soil Remediation, 1 Parr Boulevard, Richmond, CA 94806
- West County Resource Recovery/IRRF, 101 Pittsburg Ave, Richmond, CA 94801
- Richmond Sanitary Service, 3260 Blume Dr Ste 100, Richmond, CA 94806

TEFRA requires that a public hearing be held by a governing body of the jurisdiction in which a project to be financed is located, and that the governing body approve the proposed financing solely for the purposes of satisfying the requirements of TEFRA, the Code, and the California Government Code Section 6500. The Projects are within the jurisdiction of the County of Contra Costa. The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors may consider adoption of a resolution approving the issuance of the bonds on May 11, 2021. Any comments provided at this hearing will be made available to the Board of Supervisors prior to their taking action on May 11, 2021 or on such later date as the matter may be considered by the Board of Supervisors.

If there are parties present who wish to voice their opinion and provide comments on the proposed financing of the development or the issuance of the bonds, I would ask that they be recognized now by raising their hand. I will then let each person provide any written or oral testimony that they may wish to provide on this matter.
