In The Matter Of: California Department of Aging Consolidated Appropriations Act Funding, Elder Justice Title XX Funding, and CARES Act Robotic Companion Pet Project Funding – AP 2122-07 Amendment #2

WHEREAS: the Employment and Human Services Department, Area Agency on Aging, provides services to and receives funding from the California Department of Aging to support older persons and adults with disabilities through the Older Americans Act programs, and **WHEREAS,** Older Americans Act programs include, among others, congregate nutrition services, disease prevention, elder abuse prevention, family caregiver support, home delivered meals, Long-Term Care Ombudsman, and supportive services, and **WHEREAS,** these services and supports for seniors and persons with different abilities target Contra Costa County's most vulnerable populations, including family caregivers, gender and sexual minorities, homebound and isolated individuals, limited English-proficient, low-income, racial and ethnic minorities, residents living in institutionalized settings, and other underserved populations, and **WHEREAS,** the California Department of Aging has made funding available to County to bolster its Older Americans Act Ombudsman and home-delivered nutrition services to prevent elder abuse and address food insecurity in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved: That the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to execute contract amendment #2 (AP-2122-07) with the California Department of Aging to receive a total of \$6,478,915 in Consolidated Appropriations Act - H.R. 133 funding, Social Security Act Elder Justice Title XX funding, and CARES Act Robotic Companion Pet Project funding with a spending term of July 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.
