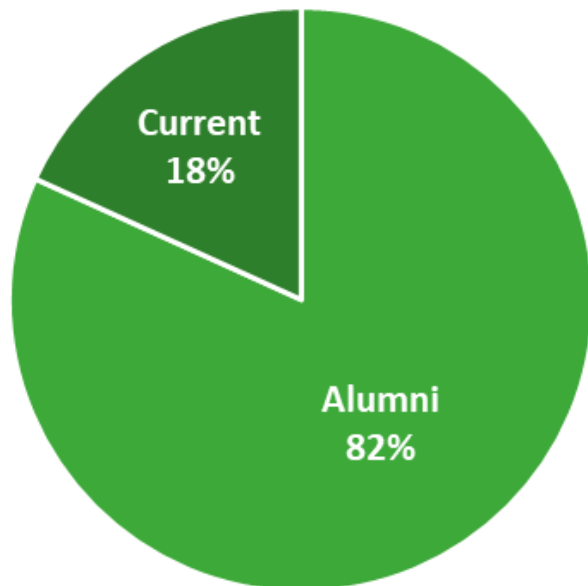

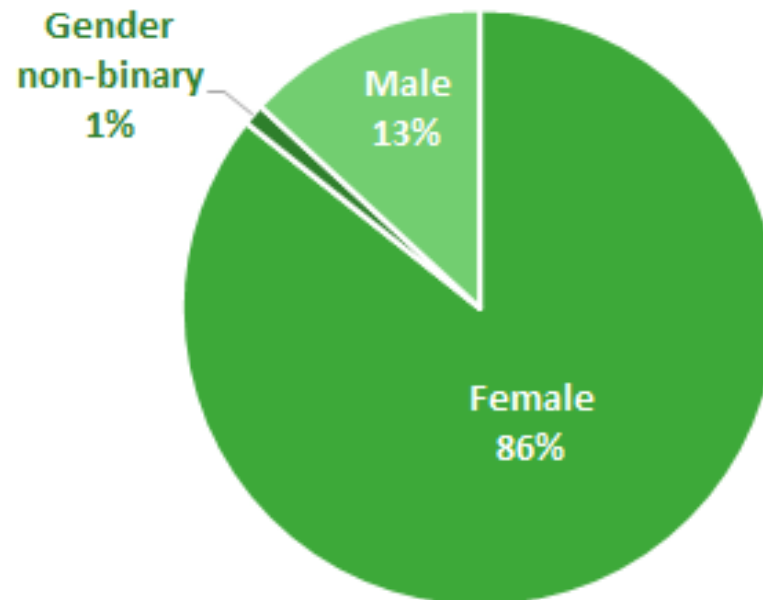

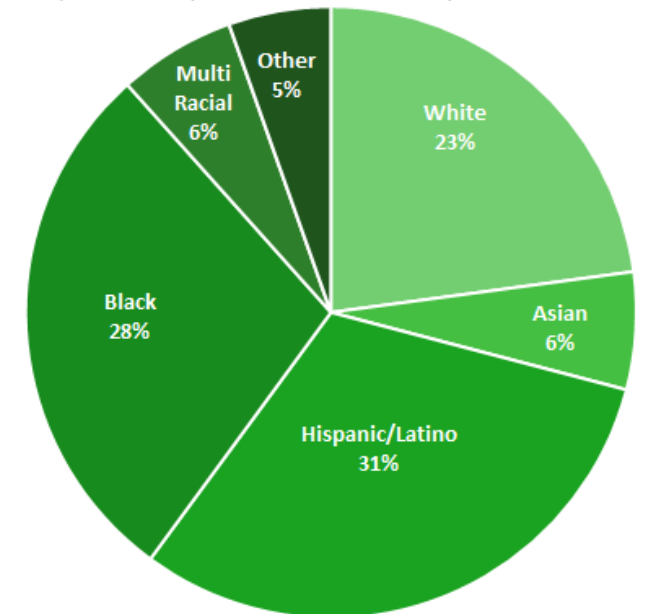
Respondents by Status



Respondents by Gender

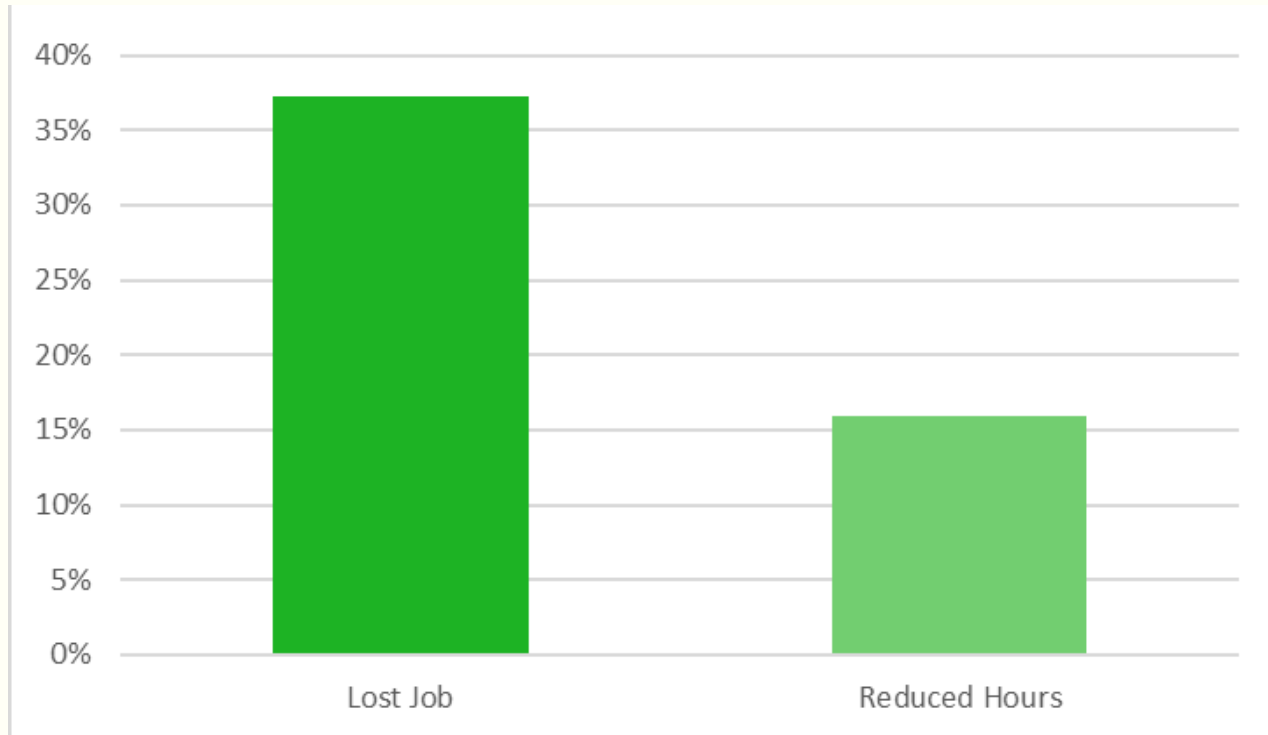

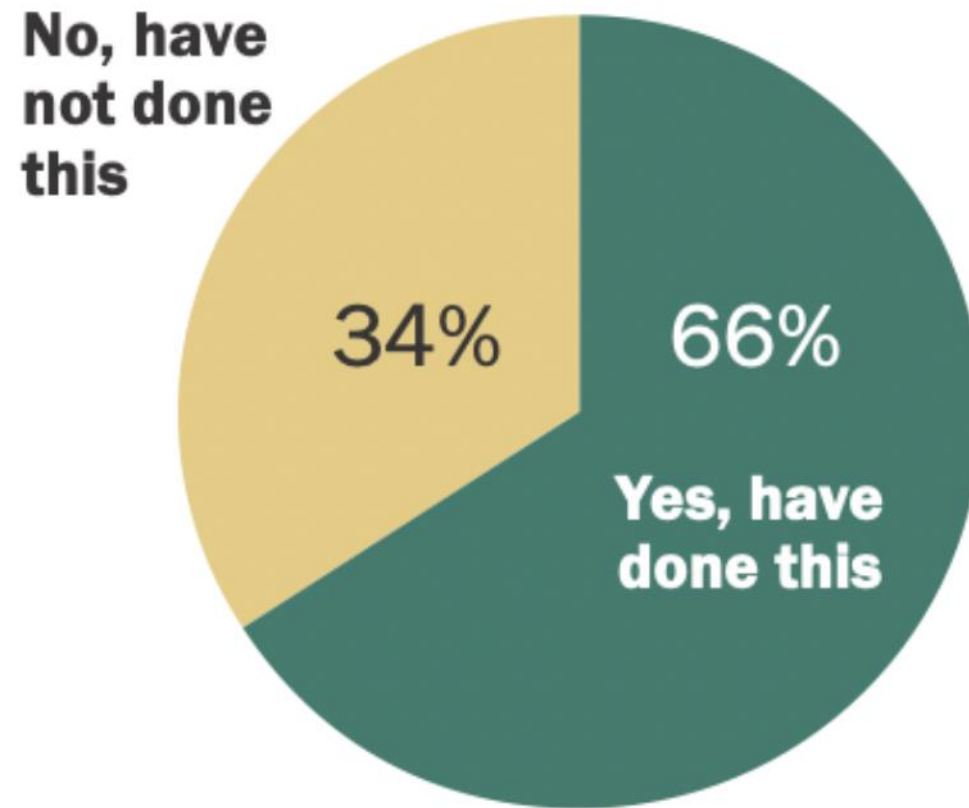

Pew: Most unemployed adults have seriously considered changing their field or occupation

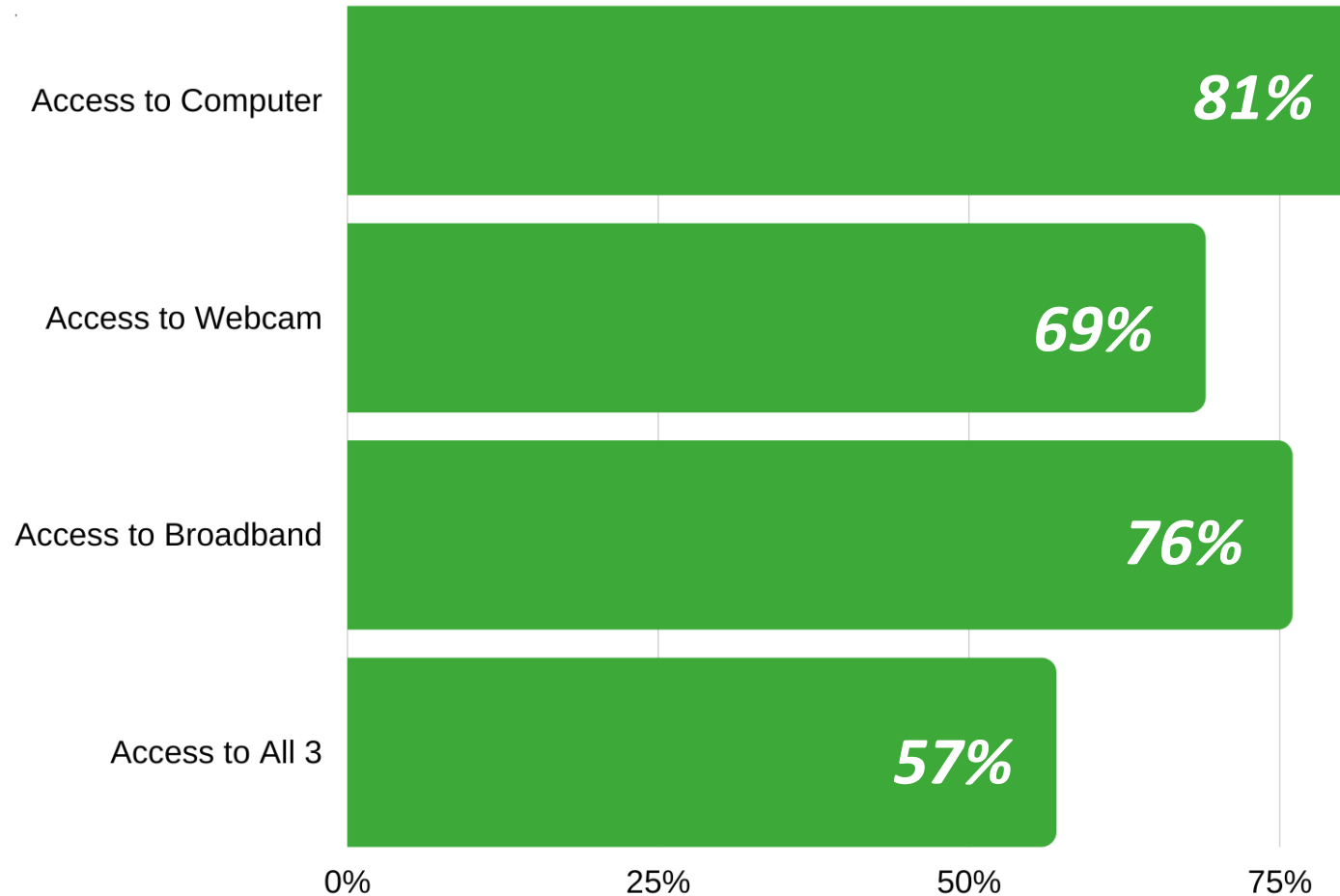
