During my 3 years there as the executive officer leading airfield and air traffic control operations (2014 -2017), I represented Air Force Interests to the Solano County Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) with regard to interference from nearby wind turbines on military aircraft and air traffic control (ATC) operations. It was my interaction with the commission technical teams and their public meetings where I advocated on behalf of the USAF that I found my expertise and experience had brought a lot to the challenges the commission were attempting to resolve.
