SUBJECT: Budget Presentation Request for Information

During the Sheriff's Office budget presentation at the Board of Supervisors meeting on April 12, 2022, I was asked to provide our authorized sworn patrol staffing levels relative to the population served in the unincorporated patrol areas. Currently, the Sheriff's Office deploys 133 sworn deputies to patrol the unincorporated areas. Using the 2020 census population count of 174,000 residents, our ratio of "deputies to 1,000 residents" is .76. This ratio is commonly used in law enforcement to assess and compare staffing levels. Notably, these assigned deputies are covering larger patrol areas and responding to calls for service over much larger coverage areas than most city law enforcement officers.

In order to assist the Board of Supervisors in evaluating our staffing levels, I have attached a table representing a similar ratio for each city in Contra Costa County.
