








DEATH RATE BY AGE GROUP SINCE JULY 2021 FOR CONTRA COSTA

COMMUNITY COVID DEATH RATES SINCE JULY 1, 2021 BY HEALTHY PLACES INDEX QUARTILE







DEATH RATES BY RACE/ETHNICITY AND AGE GROUP SINCE JULY 2021




Census Tracts in Contra Costa with Highest Death Rate




- Census Tracts with the highest death rate since July 2021
