### **Purpose**

The purpose of this Child Care Bulletin (CCB) is to provide contractors augmentations pursuant to W&IC Section 10374.5 for January 1, 2022, rate changes for Child Care Alternative Payment Programs (CAPP). Commencing January 1, 2022, the Regional Market Rate (RMR) ceilings shall be established at the greater of the 75th percentile of the 2018 RMR survey for the county or the RMR ceiling that existed on December 31, 2021. More information regarding these changes can be found in Child Care Bulletin 21-21.

#### Alternative Payment Programs (CAPP)

Attachment I displays the augmentations related to the January 1, 2022, RMR changes for CAPP. Rate increases resulting from these changes are funded by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA). Funds for the FY 2021-22 Cost of Living

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Adjustments, Hold Harmless (reimbursement based on the maximum certified hours of care rather than attendance), additional child care slots, and waived family fees were provided in Budget Act Amendments detailed in Attachment I of <a href="Child Care">Child Care</a> Bulletin 21-17.

The FY 2021-22 budget includes \$67.8 million for CAPP RMR increases effective January 1, 2022. As data associated with enrollment characteristics for new slots in FY 2021-22 is unknown, \$20 million of the total funding for CAPP is set aside to ensure availability based on projections as reported by agencies, for actual and allowable costs incurred for additional services. Consistent with current processes, agencies should work with their assigned fiscal analyst when they project they will over earn their contracts.

For the remaining \$47.8 million, caseload and characteristic data reported for October 2021 was used to determine the cost difference from the ceilings in place December 31, 2021, compared to the ceilings in place January 1, 2022. Augmentations provided in Attachment I are distributed based on each agency's percentage of the total statewide augmentation.

### CalWORKs Stages Two and Three

Consistent with existing process, because CalWORKs Stage Two is an entitlement program and CalWORKs Stage Three is treated consistently to the extent Budget Act appropriations are provided, Stage Two and Stage Three contracts are updated on an as-needed basis. Agencies should work with their assigned <u>fiscal analyst</u> when they project they will over earn their contracts.
