**In The Matter Of:** Amendment 1 to Agreement Number SP-2122-07 between the California Department of Aging and Contra Costa County for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program – Education (SNAP-Ed)

**WHEREAS**, SNAP-Ed, a federal program launched in 1992 funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Services educates communities to promote health and increase nutrition security, and **WHEREAS**, SNAP-Ed, known as CalFresh Healthy Living in California, is implemented in Contra Costa County by the Employment and Human Services Department’s Area Agency on Aging (AAA) to support the nutritional health of residents age 60 or older who are at or below 185 percent of the Federal Poverty Level, and **WHEREAS**, through its partnership with community-based organizations, the AAA prioritizes recipients of Older Americans Act Title IIIC congregate meal and home-delivered meal programs to deliver SNAP-Ed evidence-based nutrition education and obesity prevention services, and **WHEREAS**, Amendment 1 to Agreement Number SP-2122-07 increases the funding amount under this Agreement to augment nutrition education services and activities for low-income older adults in Contra Costa County.

**Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved:** the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors approve and authorize the Employment and Human Services Director, or designee, to accept additional funding in the amount of \$39,512 for a new total contract amount not to exceed \$137,653 from the California Department of Aging for Agreement Number SP-2122-07 Amendment 1 for the period October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022.
